DNR Land Use Meeting

May 26, 2008

Shelburne Community Centre

Public Land Area: Roseway Beach located in the community of Roseway in the Municipality of the District of Shelburne (District # 2 Councillor Ardith Van Buskirk)

Concern: To ensure safe, hygienic, and enjoyable public use of Roseway Beach at the same time ensuring the protection of the piping plovers, an endangered species known to nest there.

Suggested Solutions to address stated Concerns (not listed in any priority):

- (1) A larger designated parking area needs to be established
- (2) Toilets and garbage cans need to be located near the designated parking area
- (3) Appropriate signage
- (4) Public access to the beach for those with mobility challenges (Individuals using wheelchairs and walkers) – A cement viewing area and a cement pedway built down beyond the piping plover nesting sites. The public would be asked to stay on the viewing platform, the pedway, and the beach between the pedway the water.
- (5) The unpaved road leading to the beach needs to be widened approximately 1/2 mile from the beach to ensure that cars travelling in opposite directions (one going to the beach, the other leaving the beach) can pass each other safely.
